

## Logistics expert time:matters opens Sameday Air station in Tel Aviv

- Network expanded to include first Sameday Air station outside of Europe
- Cooperation with more than 22 partner airlines
- 90 direct connections a week to and from Tel Aviv

Neu-Isenburg, 23 November 2017: time:matters, the expert in worldwide Special Speed Logistics, is expanding internationally. The company has further extended its network for sameday transports by opening the first Sameday Air station outside of Europe in Tel Aviv. Prior to this, the extensive route network of time:matters GmbH for time-critical shipments needed at their destination that very same day had consisted of more than 100 destinations within Europe.

The direct integration of a non-European location into the international Sameday Air station network is an important milestone towards the further internationalization of the existing route network. Numerous companies in a number of sectors, including high-tech/semicon, medical electronics, agricultural technology and telecommunications, are located in and around this major city and can now avail themselves of the unique Sameday service for transports to and from Tel Aviv around the clock.

With the Tel Aviv station having been opened for export shipments, there will now be direct flights to the airports in Frankfurt, Munich, and Vienna. This means 90 direct connections a week to and from Tel Aviv. This will facilitate the seamless transport of shipments weighing up to 38 kg and switching between the various airlines at any time. time:matters is thereby offering its customers the fastest handling times and more cost-efficient transports. Upon request, shipments can also be picked up and delivered, including customs clearance, which is also possible even outside of the normal opening hours by arrangement. Customers can themselves go online to request quotes and track shipments using the time:matters booking portal.

“Our company has always striven to grow with our customers. The strong local presence of some of our customers in the region, especially in the high-tech/semicon sector, played a major role in our decision to open our first station outside of Europe,” said Christian Mörtl, COO of time:matters GmbH, adding: “We want to offer our customers the most comprehensive network coverage possible and the best service at all times. By opening a Sameday Air station in Tel Aviv, we are taking an important step towards further internationalization of our route network.”
